

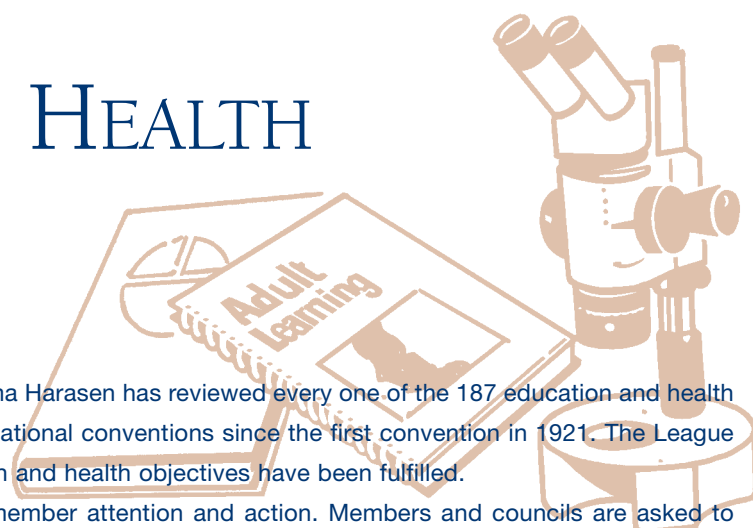
# EDUCATION AND HEALTH RESOLUTIONS
