

Canadians are concerned that medical assistance in dying (MAiD) puts the lives of people with disabilities at risk.

Are you listening to the voices of the majority of Canadians?



Under current MAiD legislation, people with disabilities may die needlessly while experiencing a crisis.

More than one-half of Canadians (55%) worry about MAiD taking the place of improvements in social service.

Sixty-eight per cent of Canadians want their political leaders to recognize the April 2019 United Nations report that criticizes Canada's lack of safeguards to protect people with disabilities and ensure access to supportive care.
