

HELPING WOMEN AND FAMILIES IN THE HOLY LAND

Our partnership with the Catholic Women's League of Canada began with "Velma's Dream" almost 10 years ago. Together, we continue to strengthen and support Christian families in Israel and Palestine, to encourage Christians to remain in their homeland and thus keep a vital Christian presence there.

The two supported projects are at **Shepherd's Field Hospital** in Beit Sahour near Bethlehem in Palestine, and the **Infant Welfare Centre** located in the Old City of Jerusalem.

SHEPHERD'S FIELD HOSPITAL

Your continual support gives essential health care to pregnant women in need, and monitors the health and development of more than 100 babies each year. This is done by providing blood tests and important supplements such as iron and Vitamin D, and essential maternal health care for very poor families. The hospital also provides health education and consultation for these mothers, post-birth.

INFANT WELFARE CENTRE

The Infant Welfare Centre was closed for a year and a half due to severe restrictions and three lockdowns in Jerusalem, which had a negative effect on children's well-being. The staff adapted and found ways to improve the mental health of children and their parents, which included workshops for parents with a counsellor and hands-on activities for kids, like cooking, science experiments, and more. The Centre also resumed its remedial education programs, focusing on academic support for teens.

HOLY LAND PILGRIMAGE

Beginning in 2013, CNEWA staff have accompanied dozens of Catholic Women's League members on an annual pilgrimage to holy sites in Israel and Palestine, and to meet with Holy Land Christians and CNEWA projects. CNEWA has put the pilgrimage on hold for now, but we hope to resume in 2024 or beyond.

Currently, 1% of the population in the Holy Land are Christians. They are in danger of disappearing altogether as the Middle East is constantly in turmoil, at times erupting into violence. In 2015, the League and the Catholic Near East Welfare Association partnered to establish Velma's Dream, one of the League's national voluntary funds.
